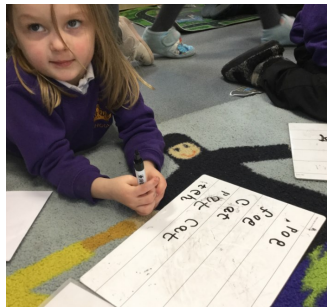
This week we have been learning about missing numbers and firemen.
