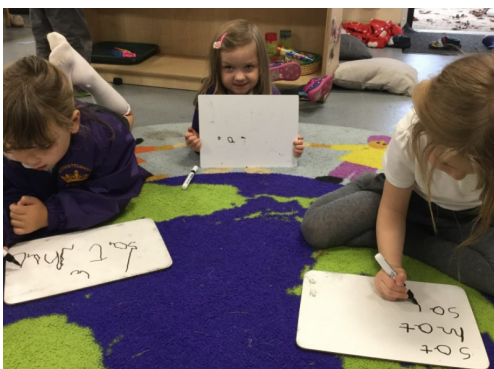
This week we have been learning how to measure.

This week Rowan Class have been measuring. As it is Harvest time, we got a phone call from Farmer John who explained that he needed help with measuring his vegetables. We used comparative language to compare them and then used non-standard measures to measure them. Some of us had a go at estimating and comparing using the measurements.

We measure how far we could roll fruit. We measured how far we could jump (whilst pretending to be a horse) and measured how far we could throw.



We have carried on learning our sounds. We have also been segmenting and blending. Some of us had a go at writing the words we sounded out.

This week we have been thinking about how our eyes and noses work. We have made our own perfume and talked about how we smell. We also realised that we breathe through our nose and that our nose helps to filter the air.

We also looked at the different parts of our bodies. We had a go at drawing our brain, heart and lungs on to our bodies.
