This week we have been learning about shape and what we can see.

We have been looking at the artist Kandinsky. We looked carefully at his work and spoke about what resources he used, what we could see and how it made us feel. We thought of some great words including 'busy' and 'nervous'. We learnt how Kandinsky produced some of his art work to music. We did the same. We listened to different types of music and expressed it through our brush stroke movements.
