This week we have been learning about verbs through our penguin topic.

This week we have carried on learning about penguins. In our afternoon sessions, we learnt about Antarctica. We found out what animals and plants live there. We thought carefully about why they might be the only things that live there and why.

We pretended to be Adelie penguins. We learnt that these penguins like to make their nests using rocks. In our penguin role play, we went outside onto the playground to collect our own rocks. We then used the rocks to find 'one less' than a given number as we know that sometimes the penguins steal rocks from one another.

We planted our potatoes that had been chitting on the windowsill. We worked as a team to pour the compost into the growing bags, planted them up the correct way and then we each put a handful of soil over them.



On Friday we made pizzas. As a group, we looked at all of the available toppings and talked about what they were and what health benefits they had. We talked about our likes and dislikes and if we had eaten them before. In groups, we made our dough. We carefully weighed out the ingredients, mixed them together and kneaded the dough. We stretched out our pizza and then applied our own toppings. To make sure our toppings were the right size, we used scissors to cut them. The kind ladies in the kitchen let us cook them in their ovens. We took them home to show our families.
